November ASCO Plenary Series: Highlighted New Research on Advanced Gastroesophageal Cancers

Early, promising results from two recent clinical trials on advanced gastroesophageal cancers were detailed during the <u>November session</u> of the <u>ASCO Plenary Series</u>. In arm A1 of the phase 2 EDGE-GASTRIC trial, the addition of anti-TIGIT domvanalimab to the PD-1 inhibitor zimberelimab and chemotherapy demonstrated an improved objective response rate and progression-free survival in patients with advanced gastroesophageal cancer. A second presentation detailed the results of a phase I trial showing promising activity of a first-in-class antibody-drug conjugate (CMG901) in patients with claudin 18.2-positive gastric or gastroesophageal junction cancer. The presentation is available to <u>watch on demand</u> at no charge. Maximize the visibility of your research. <u>Submit</u> for February's session by December 5.
