CONSULTATIVE SURVIVORSHIP CLINIC

- Care can be provided by MD, NP, or PA
- One-time visit with no follow-up, but has potential for another visit
- Ideal for providing treatment summary and care plan
- Can be implemented at a cancer center, community hospital, or private practice
- Communication and coordination with Primary Care
