GENERAL SURVIVORSHIP CLINIC

- Care can be provided by MD, NP, or PA
- Patients referred from multiple disease types and disciplines and have ongoing follow-up
- Can be implemented at a cancer center, community hospital, or private practice
- Communication and coordination with Primary Care
